## **A Note about Fundraising at Your Event**

No matter how much you think you might raise in donations at your event, remember that every penny goes straight to China to help save lives and restore value and dignity to mothers and girls. Believing that exposure of the injustice of the One-Child Policy will spark a desire to take action, we encourage there to be some way to donate at every AGA event, even if fundraising only plays a small role.

Before your event set out a goal for your fundraising. To help you decide, here are some suggestions:

- ◆ \$20 will pay for a baby shower gift for a month
- ◆ \$240 will pay for a baby shower gift for a whole year
- ◆ \$40 will pay for an elementary education for an orphan girl for a month
- ◆ \$60 will pay for a secondary education for an orphan girl for a month
- ◆ \$200 will pay for the human trafficking program for a month
- ◆ \$2500 dollars brings hope for a village

We have two main paths for donations, though you can be as creative as you'd like!

1. Online via our website ([www.allgirlsallowed.org/donate](http://www.allgirlsallowed.org/donate))
2. Print out the [AGA milk carton](#) and use it during your party/ event to collect donations.  
Remember, all checks should be made out to All Girls Allowed and every cent counts, so encourage your attendees to part with that spare change too!

After your event, gather up your donations and send them to us here at All Girls Allowed, being sure to send a note describing your event and the contact cards your attendees filled out.

## A Note about Sharing All Girls Allowed

Here at AGA we understand that what's happening in China is an intense topic to share and might not seem to fit the atmosphere of every party or event. However, we do believe there is opportunity to share what is happening in China and the work of All Girls Allowed in any environment.

Here are some tips for how to share AGA in any setting, even if it's not the time for total disclosure:

1. **Make it personal-** share how you learned about AGA and why it's important to you.
2. **Explain how it works-** outline how Baby Shower Gifts are providing life, value, and dignity for baby girls and their mothers.
3. **Highlight the good stuff-** share AGA's Stories of Hope and other successes.
4. **Involve your audience-** show your guests how they have an important role to play in supporting more women and girls into lives defined by hope through becoming monthly donors, hosting their own event, or sharing what they've learned with others.

The One-Child Policy and its results are horrific, but the successes of All Girls Allowed demonstrate how your action can change lives and what guests won't want to be a part of that?

# Throw a Party

## Party Ideas

### **Baby Shower**

Save a baby girl in China as you welcome the new baby in your life! Take 15 minutes of the next baby shower you're planning or attending, and tell your fellow attendees about All Girls Allowed and gendercide in China. If you're interested in doing something more than sharing information, plan the shower around a China theme (food, games, prizes, decorations) and purpose together to support a baby girl and her mother for a year through the Baby Shower Gift program.

### **Movie Night**

Gather your friends for a movie night for China! Order in or make your own Chinese food and watch National Geographic and Lisa Ling's *China's Lost Girls*. Afterward discuss what you saw (or learned) and with your group of friends, decide to take one action to end gendercide in China by supporting one of AGA's four programs.

### **Dinner Party**

Invite your friends to a grand dinner party. Design your place settings with information about China. Then, between courses, share with your guests about what is going on in China and what AGA is doing to end gendercide, restore value and dignity to women, and expose the injustice of the One-Child Policy. Be sure to leave your guests feeling hopeful by sharing AGA stories of hope and the opportunity to make a difference in China by donating to one of AGA's programs.

### **Milk, Cookies, and Kid's Party**

Invite your kids and fellow moms to learn about what is happening in China with you. Bake cookies and design them with AGA and girl inspired themes and hand them out to your neighbors. Design your own milk cartons to represent the missing and trafficked children in China and have the kids think about ways to raise money for AGA. Have the kids make a personal family tree and then help them make one for a Chinese family (no aunts, uncles, or siblings) and then discuss the differences or similarities with the kids.



# Hold a Fundraiser

## Fundraiser Ideas

### Have a Sale

Put your sales skills to the test to raise as much as you can for AGA's programs in China. You could sell AGA gear or get creative and make something to sell. Bake sales are always popular, as well as other homemade gifts like jewellery and greeting cards. Use the excuse to clear out your junk and have a garage sale or sell your time and your skills by offering car washes and odd jobs in your neighborhood.

### Get Sponsored

Set yourself a new challenge and get your friends and family to sponsor you. Get sporty with a 5K run, swim-a-thon or bike-a-thon, or do a sponsored fast or silence. Make sure your goal is realistic and achievable, but keep a competitive edge so that people will want to sponsor you big bucks for your efforts. To make it easy, set up a sponsorship page online and email it to everyone you know.

### Go Big

Not content with a small fundraiser? Go big and organize a fundraiser on a larger scale. Start with a big idea; what about a gala, or a silent auction? Get contributions and sponsorship from local businesses to support your event.
