In 2024, we expanded our mission in powerful new ways. Under the steadfast and faithful leadership of Barb Patch, our Director of Programs & Operations, and alongside our dedicated part time staff, partners, and supporters, All Girls Allowed became a trusted voice in the fight against in-person and online sexual exploitation. We continued to shine light into the darkest corners of abuse and violence while building real-world solutions to protect children, empower women, and challenge the attitudes and systems that perpetuate harm.

We became recognized as a leading voice in the anti-exploitation space—educating state and federal lawmakers, equipping families with life-saving knowledge, and challenging Big Tech to adopt more ethical practices. Our **Converge Conference** united hearts and minds for greater impact, and our ongoing documentary project has given voice to survivors whose stories demand justice.

Our annual investment in anti-trafficking, women's empowerment, and humanitarian initiatives provided **over 12 million people** with direct or indirect aid and education in 2024. Through impactful conferences and speaking engagements, social media outlets - reaching over 700,000 followers, 65,000+ direct messages, and AGA community calls-to-action, we educated, advocated, and mobilized like never before.

The statistics in this report represent lives touched, children protected, hearts strengthened, survivors seen and believed.

CORE OBJECTIVES

Through our programs, projects and partnerships, AGA accomplishes our mission by focusing on these core objectives:

OBJECTIVE 1: Make sexual exploitation intolerable to society by exposing its forms, causes, and devastating effects. We utilize social media campaigns (posts, blogs), direct emails, events, conferences, and our upcoming documentary to advance this objective.



OBJECTIVE 2: Equip people to recognize methods and modes of exploitation and effectively respond so as to prevent, intercept, protect, and restore those in danger. This is achieved through our ongoing communications and speaking engagements as well as an updated resource-rich website. Our documentary in the fall of 2025 will be a major component in equipping people!

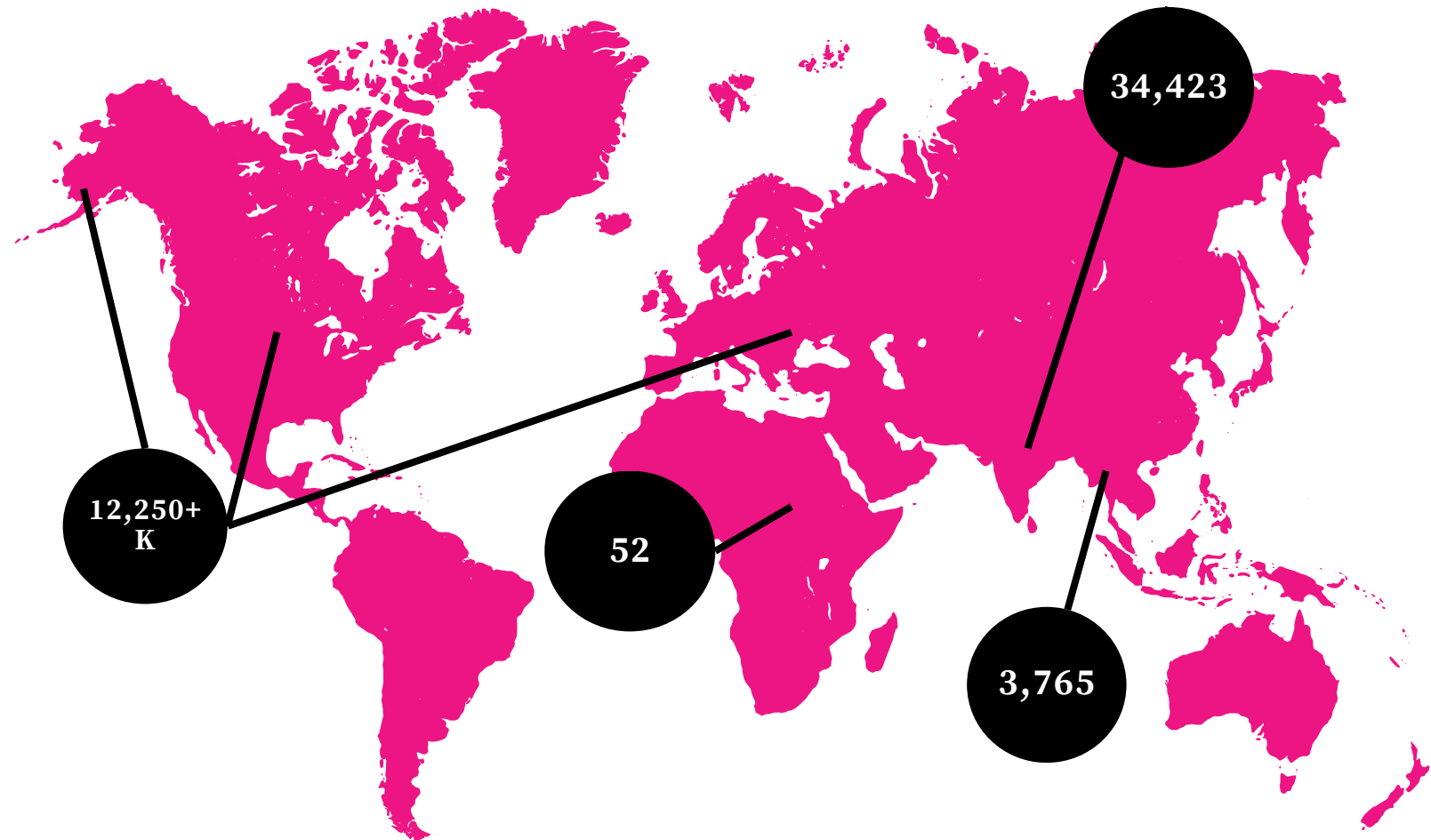
OBJECTIVE 3: Exhort men and women to honor one another as God intended. 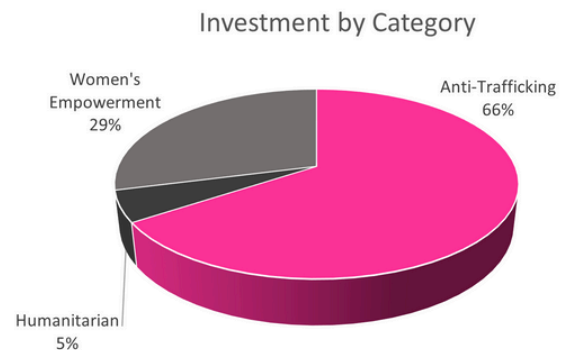
Grant Feedback from the Field

12,288,250 LIVES IMPACTED



In 2023, AGA awarded **9 grants** totaling **\$241,429** which were used in the field in 2024.

These are the numbers of individuals, as reported by our partners, who directly benefited from the services and programs enabled by the grants. The number of people who ultimately benefit is exponentially higher as empowered girls and women impact their families and communities, and those people impact others.

Current Project Update

Exposing Exploitation: NSFW

It's happening everywhere—and it's nothing like what you see in the movies.

Our powerful new documentary releasing in 2025 exposes the hidden realities of sex trafficking and exploitation in America. Through firsthand accounts from law enforcement, experts in the field, and courageous survivors, the documentary uncovers how exploitation really happens, how people escape, and challenges they face on the road to healing. Most importantly, it offers practical ways we can protect our loved ones and support survivors in rebuilding their lives. Every story reveals a different face of injustice.

- *Mariam was only 3 years old when a trusted relative began abusing her. While other children played in kindergarten, she was forced to watch porn to learn various sex acts to please her abusers.*
- *A father said good night to his teen son, only to find him dead by morning, the family's gun by his side. What happened during the night was a chilling encounter. Hundreds of outstanding teen boys are targeted every year in the same way.*
- *A teenage girl, desperately hoping to find a guy to take care of her and make ends meet, turned to Seeking Arrangements. She earned almost nothing and endured repeated abuse, but felt too unsafe to report it, believing police would treat her worse than a prostituted person.*
- *A high school girl died trying to rescue her trafficked sister. Her body was found burned beyond recognition. Her courage cost her everything.*

These are real stories from real families. They represent thousands more voices - some still silenced by fear, shame, or threats.

Our response is clear:

✦ Expose the truth. Protect the vulnerable. Help survivors. End the demand.

We are shining a light on what has been hidden, confronting what culture tolerates, and declaring hope and freedom in Jesus' name.

This is more than a film series. It's a movement to end exploitation by changing hearts, laws, and lives. With God's help, the end of exploitation has begun. May you join us to be part of the movement to end this end time massive evil against humanity!

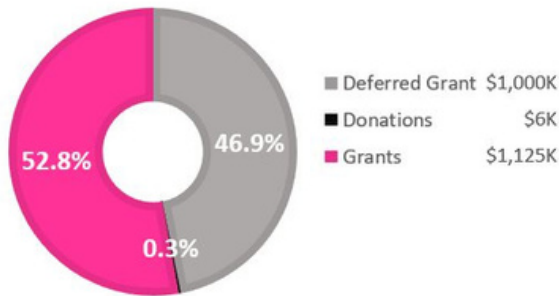

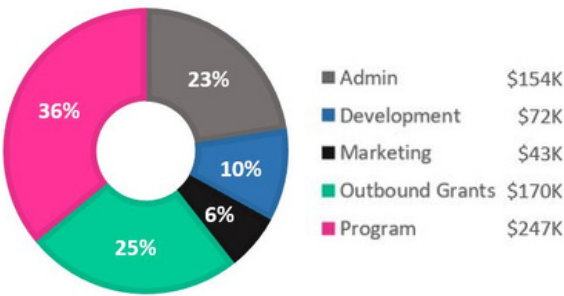
